A Romanian church group did a survey of all the evangelical churches in that area a few years ago, and found that there are less than 300 members in all of the churches combined.



We are planning to help a national pastor, Mihai and his family, to relaunch a church in the city of Berca, just outside of Buzau. We are also hoping to live in the city, with the goal of establishing a church there as well.
