An Opportunity to Build

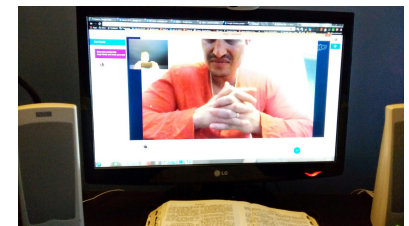
